Charles Washington Hall is a major Charles Town, West Virginia community landmark, built in 1874 and dedicated to Charles Washington, brother of President George Washington and founder of Charles Town. Since then the Hall has been home to the United States Post Office and to a number of restaurants and businesses.

Project Description

Grand Light fabricated a custom, handcrafted steel chandelier that invoked a 21st century interpretation of a 19th century chandelier. The chandelier featured forty-eight lights and a hand applied satin black finish.

The fixture was wired with UL listed components and HIPOT tested in accordance with UL standard 1598.
