

Yellowstone National Park - Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel

Property History

Located at the northern end of Yellowstone National Park, this rustic wintertime hotel is a 10-minute walk from Mammoth Hot Springs, 2.3 miles from Boiling River and 4 miles from Undine Falls. In winter, Mammoth is the only visitor accommodations in Yellowstone accessible by automobile and is a hub for snowy adventures, offering access to incredible wildlife watching, Nordic skiing, snowshoeing, ice skating and a launching point for over-snow explorations of the park's interior.

Project Description

Grand Light restored eight original fixtures that were made of pottery. These fixtures were made by Weller Pottery of Zanesville, Ohio. The original finish was discovered to be a two tone glaze that was revealed after Grand Light artisans removed a coat of paint that had covered it. This original finish was conserved and received a UV resistant museum grade wax.

There were also 2 fixture that were not original and were a porous cast replica. These replicas were stripped and painted to resemble the Weller replicas.

All fixtures were rewired with UL listed components and Hi-Pot tested in accordance with UL standards.
