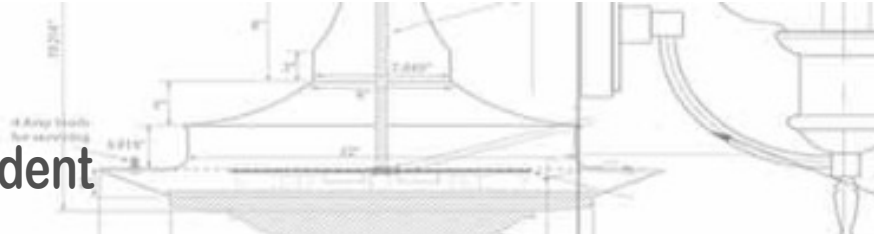


Ryan Stockman
